## WHAT TO DO IN AN EMERGENCY

TYPE OF EMERGENCY	RESPONSE	
Health Threatening Fire, toxic spills, gas leak, leave building and go to EAP#104, located on Serra Mall, just past the water fountain on the sidewalk	<ul> <li>Pull the fire alarm, if alarm is not already sounding.</li> <li>Leave the building immediately, using the marked emergency exit route.</li> <li>Meet at the Evacuation Assembly Point (EAP #104)</li> <li>DO NOT re-enter the building until cleared.</li> </ul>	
Major Earthquake	<ul> <li>Take cover; wait for shaking to stop.</li> <li>Leave building &amp; meet at Evacuation Assembly Point (EAP # 104)</li> <li>DO NOT pull the fire alarm unless there is a health-threatening hazard.</li> </ul>	
Life-Threatening Medical Emergency (if in doubt, treat as an emergency)	<ul> <li>Call out for help.</li> <li>Dial 9-911* or 911 immediately (DO NOT hang up until told to do so.)</li> <li>DO NOT move victim unless necessary.</li> <li>AED Units are located near: Allen Gowning room entry, Annex 127X.</li> </ul>	
Non-Health Threatening Emergency (Building and facilities)	<ul> <li>Emergencies during work hours call Kenny Green (650) 804-2032.</li> <li>After hours, call Work Control at 3-2281.</li> <li>First Aid kits are located near: Allen Gowning room entry and Annex B104X.</li> </ul>	
<b>Electrical Power Outage</b>	Within 15 seconds, emergency lights and lab ventilation systems will come on.  Leave the lab through the nearest exit.	
Chemical Spill < 30ml	Only if your training covers it, use proper protective equipment and clean up.	
Spill > 30 ml or will take longer than 15 minutes to clean up	<ul> <li>During work hours, notify staff on lab page phone or Duty Phone (650) 521-7306</li> <li>After work hours, call EH&amp;S at (650) 725-9999</li> </ul>	
Odor in the Lab	<ul> <li>Leave the immediate area and report odor to Work Control, (650)723-2281.</li> <li>If no alarm is sounding, make sure others leave (use Lab page phone)</li> <li>During work hours, notify staff on lab page phone or Duty Phone (650) 521-7306</li> </ul>
